BARN RULES
FAIR DATES ARE FEBRUARY 5TH - 15TH, 2010

1. NO ALCOHOL or ILLEGAL DRUGS or PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (i.e.: kissing, hugging etc.) will be permitted on the fairgrounds. Exhibitor's found in use of alcohol or drugs or displays of sexual activity will result in immediate removal from the fairgrounds, and their animal will be disqualified.
2. NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS will be permitted inside fair tents.
3. Exhibitors are required to check-in upon arrival at the barn, to the Ag Office.
4. Exhibitors will not be allowed to stay overnight without the prior approval of the Ag Committee.
5. Exhibitors are required to care for and feed their animals as instructed by the Ag. Committee.
6. Stalls and pens should be maintained in an attractive manner from opening of the fair to closing of the tent each day.
7. All tools (shovels, stall forks, wheelbarrows, etc.) shall be furnished by the exhibitor and will be stored in designated areas of the exhibit tent. **NO TOOLS MARKED CCF WILL BE USED BY EXHIBITORS.**
8. For the sake of neatness only signs approved by the Ag Committee will be permitted. Received approval before hanging.
9. All major clipping will be done before arrival at the fairgrounds.
10. All grooming/washing/touch-up clipping will be done in the wash rack area with the Ag Comm. Okay. Exhibitors are required to do their own grooming with the assistance of other exhibitors only. **NO PARENT PARTICIPATION OF ANY KIND.**
11. On the nights/days of the shows and sale the exhibit tent will close thirty (30) minutes prior to starting time. The people permitted in the exhibit tent are the exhibitors, livestock committee members, designated volunteers and/or their leaders.
12. Exhibitors shall wear appropriate attire while in the agriculture tent - Jeans, Shirt w/sleeves, and closed toed shoes. - **NOT APPROPRIATE ARE** Shorts, open-toed shoes, crop top shirts (No belly's showing).
13. All show boxes can be delivered on Thursday February 4, 2010 between 5pm-8pm or bring on Feb. 5, 2010 when your animal comes. Show Box maximum size is 30"X30"X66". **THIS YEAR THE FAIR MEMBERS HAVE SOMEONE GIVING A SHOW BOX AWARD.**
14. For liability and safety reasons exhibitors should not move exhibit animals from their designated area while visitors are in the barn. Exceptions to this rule will be approved by the Ag committee. Exhibitors must be with all livestock while being moved from place to place.
15. Exhibitors should make every precaution to keep the public from coming in contact with their show animals. (Note: Be polite to everyone and ask they please don't touch, if they do remind them to wash their hands)
16. Parking - Exhibitors will not be allowed to park in back of Ag Barn, you must park in the main parking area designated by the fair association.
17. The Ag Committee shall have the right to handle, examine and treat any animal at any time if necessary.
18. All exhibitors are required to stay for all livestock shows. Their show is just as important as yours is to you. Roll call will be taken and any exhibitor caught leaving the show arena during the show will result in a \$50.00 fine.
