HOG & LAMB SHOW & SALE RULES AND INFORMATION

FAIR DATES ARE FEBRUARY 3rd – 12TH, 2012

HOGS

- 1** Exhibitors must adhere to the Charlotte County Fair Market Animal Exhibitor Rules.
- 2** It is recommended that gilts or barrows weigh between 80 pounds and no more than 120 pounds at the initial weigh-in on Saturday, October 29, 2011 at the Fairgrounds @ 8:00 am – 10:00am in line no exceptions. Feed Program is 97 days on feed. Hogs in excess of 300 pounds will be sold at 300 pound maximum. Regardless of final weight.
- 3** Exhibitors and their animals must be at the fairgrounds for the final weigh-in on Sunday, January 29, 2012 @ 8:00am till 10:00am. In line no exceptions. To be eligible for entry the hog must weigh a minimum of 220 pounds at the final weigh-in.
- 4** The C.C. Fair Ag Committee will class hogs after final weigh-in.
- 5** The Modified Danish System will be used in making awards. The animals are placed according to their merit into three groups: Blue, Red, and White. All animals in the Blue Group are then placed numerically with the first place in each class competing for the appropriate championship. Only animals in the Blue group will be considered for championship awards Premiums will be paid as follows: Blue=\$6, Red=\$4, and White=\$2, with Grand Champion=\$75, Reserve Grand Champion=\$50, First Place Class Winners=\$15. Showmanship Winner's = 1st Place \$75, 2nd Place \$50.
- 6** Exhibitor & 2 Parent Passes will be available at final Weigh-in. Pass to include admission and parking. There will be no parking in rear of barn.
- 7** Entry forms are due at the Fairground Office no later than October 10, 2011.

LAMBS

- 1** Exhibitors must adhere to the Charlotte County Fair Market Animal Exhibitor Rules.
- 2** It is recommended that open ewes or wethers weigh a minimum of 55 pounds at the initial check-in on Saturday, October 29, 2011 at the Fairgrounds @ 10:00 am – 10:30am. In line no exceptions Feed Program is 97 days on feed.
- 3** Exhibitors and their animals must be at the fairgrounds for the final weigh-in on Sunday, January 29, 2011 @ 10:00am till 10:30am. To be eligible for entry the lamb must weigh a minimum of 100 pounds at the final weigh-in. Lambs must not be older than 12 months of age and must still have milk teeth.
- 4** The C.C. Fair Ag Committee will class lamb after final weigh-in.
- 5** The Modified Danish System will be used in making awards. The animals are placed according to their merit into three groups: Blue, Red, and White. All animals in the Blue Group are then placed numerically with the first place in each class competing for the appropriate championship. Only animals in the Blue group will be considered for championship awards Premiums will be paid as follows: Blue=\$6, Red=\$4, and White=\$2, with Grand Champion=\$75, Reserve Grand Champion=\$50, First Place Class Winners=\$15. Showmanship Winner's = 1st Place \$75, 2nd Place \$50.
